- 1.- Recyclemania/Waste Reduction Week (February 11th through February 16th, at the main Library). Action items:
- a) Decide on name Waste Reduction Week? Moving Towards Absolute Zero?

Stephanie suggested that the idea should be towards waste reduction rather than absolute zero waste.

It was agreed to call it Waste Awareness Week.

b) PR for Susan Selke's event, , "Rethinking the Packaging of the Products You Buy - Is There Hope to Reduce Waste?" on February 13th.

As part of the LEC's Environmental Series event, there will be a brown bag lunch session presentation by Susan Selke on Sustainable Packaging. It will take place in the Reference Instruction room (1st. floor) from 12:10 p.m. to 12:50 p.m. Posters will be displayed announcing this event.

- c) Posters for Recyclemania /Waste Reduction Week from Recycling/Surplus. Recyclemania will start on February 3rd and end on March 30th (8 weeks). MSU Recycling /Surplus will advertise these events. Heidi has asked for four additional Recyclemania posters to be put on library easels to be displayed during the duration of the event, when other library events are not occurring.
- d) Other PR ideas to talk to Ruth Daoust (Surplus/Recycling) about stickers/flyers telling the story of where the recycled material ends up, poster tracking how much goes to the landfill from the Library each day.

The amount of waste going to the landfill will be measured at the start of the Waste Awareness Week and at the end.

- e) Temporary reduction of trash bins/landfill stickers or signs near trash cans. Susie Garmo will work with the custodial supervisors regarding the temporary removal of some trash bins.
